




- Printed in 1978

- Possible authors: Sakhnin, Murzin, Agranovskiy





Authorship according to Murzin

- Vozrozhdenie: Anatoliy Agranovskiy
- Tselina: Aleksandr Murzin









Outcomes

- Brezhnev's memoirs differ from other examples of Soviet official literature.
- They could have been written by Murzin or by a team of authors.

Possible Further Research

- To digitalize Murzin's books and feed them to the system.
- To digitalize Brezhnev's personal diaries (recently published) and use it as well.
- To cover also dissident writers of the same period (not sure if it is necessary).
