


# Time for blogging!

## 3. Palace Square and street musicians





Address: Palace Square

The main square of St. Petersburg, an architectural ensemble that emerged in the second half of XVIII - the first half of the XIX century. The area is listed on the World Heritage List. The construction of B.F. Rastrelli in 1754-1762 of the Winter Palace marked the beginning of the

architectural ensemble of Palace Square. K.I. Rossi made a huge contribution to the formation of the architectural image, bringing the ensemble to its logical conclusion.

The photo on Palace should be in the archive of every tourist, it is interesting to visit any guest and resident of the city. First, to admire the view and architecture, to enjoy freedom and scale, to give free rein to the imagination and to think that she saw the Palace Square, who walked

along it. Secondly, with the onset of heat, street musicians appear on the square, giving the atmosphere and mood to all who are walking and just hurrying about their business.

Vasylyevsky Island, stock Exchange and Rostral columns: meet the sunrise

Do you remember last time you've seen sunrise not because you worked till 5 am, but because you wanted to or just woke up that early? I certainly didn't, until my last trip to Saint-Petersburg. Not only sunrises (when the weather is good) are beautiful, but they also can become great source of inspiration and give you a break from noise and crowds of big city. Sometimes places at chilly dawn seem younger due to calmness and lack of people and that somehow gives you sense of hope and strength. Don't we all need that sometimes?



To my mind, the best spot for admiring a dawn in Saint-Petersburg is one between Rostral columns, that were built by J. Thomon in the beginning of XIX century, when classicism was popular in Russian Empire. This ground before Stock Exchange was depicted by many artists and mentioned by many poets in their works. To my mind, the most touching words that defines this place as one of the best in the city is the ones from final song of the rock-opera «Juno and Avos» composed by A. Rybnikov: main hero said goodbye to Saint-Petersburg by voicing his regret to never see this part of the Vasilyevsky Island again.

Afraid of catching a cold? I recommend ending your early morning stroll at one of Nevsky Avenue café having something hot and tasty to warm yourself and energize for upcoming day. It is worth noting that Nevsky Avenue almost lined for East-West direction, so while going from Vasylyevsky Island to café you will go towards the «awakening» sun.
