

This additional map precisely reflects the territory around HSE. It supplements the decorated map on the reverse side and will help you find your way in the district. It contains all the neighbouring buildings and streets. The sites included along the routes are highlighted in colour and numbered. The numeration on both maps is the same. As you move from one site to another, you'll complete a walking tour around HSE in about 40 minutes before returning.

#aroundhse

The neighbourhood surrounding HSE's buildings on Myasnitskaya Ulitsa has preserved a unique atmosphere of genuine old Moscow. Quiet small streets between the Boulevard Ring and Kitay Gorod are an ideal place to walk and get to know the capital's history. Here, magnificent churches stand alongside small mansions, and apartment buildings designed by renowned architects appear next to longstanding household buildings.

The map you are holding in your hands includes both popular landmarks and inconspicuous city elements. Even if you've worked or studied here for a long time, these routes will reveal something new for you in this Moscow district. The walk in each of them will take about 40 minutes. Moscow's oldest operating telephone station, a restored sign from the 1920s, old lamp posts, a real sun clock - you'll see these and many other things as you use this map to walk around HSE's neighbourhood.

Don't be afraid to walk off the route. You are in the city centre, and despite the intricate network of small streets, you can't get lost here. Look in the arches, walk in the courtyards, take shortcuts from the paths and you'll get to know the district and feel its spirit. Historical artefacts and exciting architectural details meet you every step of the way here. Look around and don't miss them!
