Annex No. 2, Directive No. 29n

Once a year, all employees of educational and academic organizations of all types must take part in mandatory medical examinations (check-ups).

The examinations include the following:

Screenings by the following specialists:

- 1. General Practitioner;
- 2. Ophthalmologist;
- 3. Dermatovenerologist;
- 4. Otorhynolaringologyst
- 5. Psychiatrist / Narcologist;
- 6. Dentist and Infectious Disease Specialist (by referral only);
- 7. Gynecologist bacterial and pap-test (only for women);
- 8. Mammology or breast ultrasonography once every two years (only for woman above the age of 40).

Tests:

- 1. Blood test:
 - clinical (Hb, colour index, RBCs, PLTs, WBCs, white blood cell formula, ESR, HIV, syphilis);
 - bio-chemical screening for glucose, and cholesterol, clinical blood test, clinical urine test (USG, protein, sugar, urinary sediment);
- 2. electrocardiography;
- 3. digital fluorography or X-Ray analysis with two lung projections (frontal and right lateral).
